












Deep Roots in Maasai Culture





HERB-CRUSTED LAMB CHOPS WITH RED WINE REDUCTION

Ingredients:

For the lamb chops:

- 8 Lamb chops (about 1-inch thick)
- 2 Tablespoons olive oil
- 1 Tablespoon fresh rosemary, chopped
- 1 Tablespoon fresh thyme, chopped
- 2 Cloves garlic, minced
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper

For the red wine reduction:

- 1 Cup red wine

(Cabernet sauvignon or Merlot works best)

- 1 Cup beef or veal stock
- 1 Shallot, finely chopped
- 1 Clove garlic, minced
- 1 Tablespoon butter
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper

For the Herb Crust:

- 1/2 cup breadcrumbs (preferably fresh)
- 1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 2 tablespoons fresh parsley, chopped
- 1 tablespoon fresh rosemary, chopped
- 1 tablespoon fresh thyme, chopped
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 2 tablespoons olive oil

Instructions:

Prepare the lamb chops:

- In a small bowl, mix the olive oil, Rosemary, Thyme, Garlic, salt, and Pepper.
- Rub the mixture all over the lamb chops and let them marinate for at least 30 minutes at room temperature, or up to overnight in the refrigerator.

Make the herb crust:

- In a bowl, combine the breadcrumbs, Parmesan, Parsley, Rosemary, Thyme, Garlic, and olive oil. Mix well.

Cook the lamb chops:

- Preheat the oven to 400°f (200°c).
- Heat a large oven-proof skillet over medium-high heat.
- Sear the Lamb chops for 2-3 minutes on each side until browned.
- Press the herb crust mixture onto one side of each Lamb chop.
- Transfer the skillet to the oven and roast for 10-15 minutes, depending on the desired doneness (internal temperature of 145°f (63°c) for medium-rare).

Prepare the red wine reduction:

- In a small saucepan, sauté the shallot and garlic in butter over medium heat until softened.
- Add the red wine and bring to a boil. Reduce the heat and simmer until the wine is reduced by half.
- Add the beef stock and continue to simmer until the sauce is thickened and coats the back of a spoon.
 - Season with salt and pepper to taste.

Serve:

- Place the lamb chops on a serving platter.
- Drizzle the red wine reduction over the lamb chops.
- Garnish with fresh herbs and serve with your favorite sides, such as roasted vegetables or mashed potatoes.
