

Working as a porter has reinforced the ethos of our



Ingredients:

- 2 salmon fillets
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1/4 cup soy sauce
- 1 tablespoon Sriracha (or other hot sauce)
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice


Instructions:

- 1. Preheat oven to broil. Pat salmon fillets dry and season with salt and pepper.
- 2. In a large oven-safe skillet, heat butter and olive oil over medium-high heat. Add garlic and cook for 30 seconds, or until fragrant.
- 3. Stir in soy sauce, Sriracha, honey, and lemon juice. Bring to a simmer and cook for 1 minute.
- 4. Add the salmon fillets to the pan, skin-side down. Cook for 3 minutes, or until golden brown.
- 5. Baste the salmon with the glaze and transfer the pan to the oven. Broil for an additional 5-6 minutes, or until the salmon is cooked through.
- 6. When cooked serve with sweet potato mash.








