**6 Crescent Island-Animal Walk:** This tranquil island sanctuary on Lake Naivasha boasts more animals per acre than any other park in Kenya. Here, you get to walk among the yellow barked "fever trees" as well as with the park animals, some of which include giraffes, zebras, thompson's & grant's gazelles.
